

Bodega Bay Elementary School, a small school in the Shoreline Unified School District, is located on a knoll overlooking the bay and the Pacific Ocean. The school serves thirty students in grades kindergarten through fifth grade.



The school was also the only Marin County School to receive a rating of "Honorable Mention" in the competition for California Distinguished School in 2004.



Serving the student population are two experienced teachers and an array of committed support personnel, community volunteers and imaginative programs.

Loretta Smith teaches kindergarten, first, and second grade. She is a seasoned teacher, who has taught for 25 years. Before she became a teacher, she worked for 10 years with the Department of Forestry. She creates a friendly, fun and exciting place to learn. Her class includes a year long theme that uses the local community and environment to teach concepts through real world experiences. She loves to share her enthusiasm for nature, singing, history and good books. Ms. Smith lives in Santa Rosa and in her spare time enjoys hiking, gardening and cooking.

Mr. Josh Risley teaches third, fourth, and fifth grade. He has been teaching for the Shoreline Unified School District for 16 years and previously he taught at a charter school as part of Harmony School District. What he loves about teaching is to make learning fun and meaningful and as a result he says the students are motivated to learn! He uses a thematic approach for teaching and was trained in Project Based learning.
